## Feed Format

The file contains 10 fields. Listed below are the field names with its corresponding definition:

Field name	Comments
<u>CatID</u>	CNET Category ID
CategoryName	CNET Category name in US English
<u>AtrID</u>	Searchable attribute ID
AttributeName	Searchable attribute name in US English
Status	Active – Searchable attribute that is currently active Deactivated – Searchable Attribute that is currently deactivated
StatusChange	NewlyAdded – Searchable attribute that was recently added (during the last two months) PlannedDeactivation – Searchable attribute that is currently active but planned for deactivation
NewAtrID	Attribute ID of the searchable attribute, which replaces the deactivated (or planned for deactivation) attribute
NewAttributeName	Replacement searchable attribute name is US English
CreationDate	Creation date of the searchable attribute in YYYY-MM-DD format
DeactivationDate	Deactivation date (or scheduled deactivation date) of the searchable attribute in YYYY-MM-DD format

NOTE: The feed does not include searchable attributes that has been deactivated prior to January 1, 2010.
